WOODS TO WORK WITH S.B. ALLIANCE OF BUSINESSMEN

Marvin W. Reimer, president and general manager of The San Company was named by President Nixon as San Bernardino County's metropolitan chairman for the National Alliance of Businessmen.

The purpose of the alliance is to find jobs for the hard-core unemployed in private business, based on a hire first principle followed by on-the-job training and remedial counseling to retain hires as productive employees.

Working with Reimer will be three San Bernardino area executives, Earl S. Reynolds, retired public relations director of Kaiser Steel Corp., Fontana, as Metropolitan director.

John H. Woods Jr., program control administrator for THW systems, Inc., and a member of the San Bernardino Unified School District board, will be job procurer and placement manager.

Richard Nelson, State Department of Employment, manager of San Bernardino branch, will become manager of recruiting and government programs.

Loaned Executives, Reynolds, Woods, and Nelson will serve for one year at the expense of their employers.

The National Alliance of Businessmen was created in President Nixon's manpower message to Congress in January.

Through the Secretary of Labor, \$400 million has been allocated for the national program, the County's share was not disclosed at this time. The S.B. County goal is to employ 700 adults full-time and place 475 youths in a summer work program.
