Along with the scholarship, the Adrianettes also participated in school integration efforts and hosted events on college awareness. In 1973, Mrs. Florence Coleman was the representative for the group at the San Francisco College Entrance Examination Workshop. This group of women were determined to get better access and resources for Black youth in higher ED.
